WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri BHARAT BABU.N presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus

- i. declaring the impugned rejection orders passed by the 2nd respondent vide Rc.No.14/PAC-11/2023 dated 10.10.2025 in respect of the 1st petitioner, Rc.No.18/PAC-11/2023 dated 10.10.2025 in respect of the 2nd petitioner, and Rc.No. 04/PAC- 11/2024 dated 10.10.2025 dated 10.10.2025 in respect of the 3rd petitioner, rejecting the claims of the petitioners for absorption into aided vacancies, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India, and contrary to the directions issued by this Hon'ble Court in the common order dated 27.06.2025
- ii. Consequently set aside the aforesaid impugned rejection orders and direct the respondents 1 to 3 to consider and absorb the petitioners into the existing sanctioned aided vacancies in the posts of Lecturers in their respective subjects in the 4th respondent College, with effect from the date of their initial appointment or from the date of arising of vacancy, with all consequential benefits including pay, seniority and arrears;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri BHARAT BABU.N Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Higher Education for R1 to R3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
