Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances
stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be
pleased to stay further trial proceedings in FCOP No. 110/2018 on the file of
the Court of the Judge, Family Court - CUM -V Additional District Judge,
Tirupati unaffected interlocutory proceedings in FCOP No. 110/2018, Pending
disposal of CRP 1412 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof-and upon hearing the arguments of SRI N PAVAN KUMAR [PARTY IN PERSON] for the Petitioner, the Court made the following

ORDER

“The party-in-person filed the revision against the order in I.A.No.1303 of 2025 in F.C.O.P. No.110 of 2018 on the file of Family Court-cum-V Additional District Judge, Tirupati dated 24.01.2026.

He further submits that, against the order of the Division Bench of this Court in C.C.No.617 of 2019 dated 12.09.2025, the respondent herein filed S.L.P.(C) No.7726 of 2026 wherein the impugned order was stayed and the same is in force vide order dated 27.05.2026. The Apex Court adjourned the matter to 20.08.2026 with a specific observation that “in the meantime, interim order to continue”.

He further submits that since it is only F.C.O.P. and as the matter is being pursued before the Hon'ble Apex Court by both the parties, the proceedings may be differed till the disposal of the above said S.L.P., for which he seeks stay of all further proceedings in the main F.C.O.P. before the trial court.

Considering the said submissions and in view of the above said facts and circumstances, the further proceedings in F.C.O.P. No.110 of 2018 on the file of Family Court-cum-V Additional District Judge, Tirupati are stayed pending further orders.
