	29.04.2026	<u>DR. J</u> The learned Government Pleader for Higher Education takes notice for the respondent No.1 and the learned Standing counsel takes notice for the respondent Nos. 2 and 3. As contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner, upon perusal of the orders passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.A. No. 1013 of 2023, dated 12.08.2024, there is a specific direction to the respondents to pay subsistence allowance with effect from 01.04.2023 and to complete the enquiry within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of the said order. However, the respondents have failed to conclude the proceedings within the stipulated time and have also not released the entire subsistence allowance, having paid the same only up to July, 2025. Even as per the instructions placed by the learned Standing Counsel, it is evident that subsistence allowance has been paid to the	

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		petitioner only up to July, 2025. Considering the same, there shall be a direction to the respondents to release the remaining subsistence allowance, in terms of the directions issued by the Division Bench of this Court in the above-referred judgment, within a period of two (02) months. Post the matter after summer vacation, 2026 <u>DR, J</u> klk	

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
