The same has been allowed. 2. Issue notice to the respondent. 3. In addition to the normal mode of service, the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent by registered post and acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry before the next date of listing. 4. I.A.No.1 of 2026 has been filed, which in substance for stay of the order; but, the prayer is framed as one to allow the C.M.A. finally. 5. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant, however, confines the request to grant of stay of operation of the impugned order. 6.
