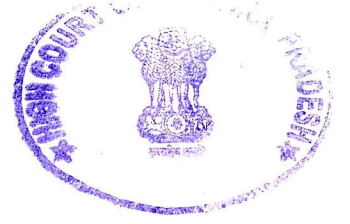

The present Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is filed against the order and decree dated 08.01.2026 passed in the H.M.O.P.No.104 of 2022 on the file of the court of the III Additional Civil Judge, (Senior Division) Kakinada.

Considering the same and in view of the appearance of the respondents, this Court deems it appropriate to refer the matter to the Mediation Centre, High Court of Andhra Pradesh. The Mediation Centre shall issue necessary notices, fix the date for the appearance of the parties, and endeavour to settle the dispute. The said exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
