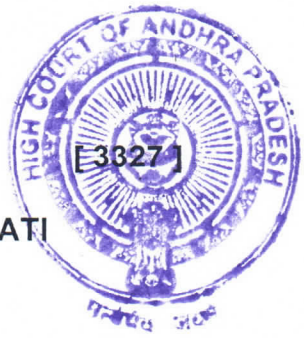

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in support of the criminal petition, the

High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in C.C. No. 772/2023 on the file of the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court, Anaparthi, East Godavari District in Crime (FIR) No. 165 of 2021 of the S.H.O. of Biccavole Police Station, for the offence punishable Under section 498-A IPC, 3 86 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act (DP Act) including with the appearance, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2936 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following Order:

“Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice for respondent No.1 and seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry within a period of three (3) weeks.

On a perusal of the material on record goes to show that except making an omnibus accusation against the petitioners herein/A2 and A3 that they supported A1 in harassing the de facto complainant for additional dowry, no specific accusation has been attributed against them.

In the circumstances, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioners herein in CC No.772 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Anaparthi, East Godavari district.
