Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents, especially Respondent No. 3, in cancelling the tender notification dated 31.03.2026 pursuant to the press note dated 08.04.2026, as illegal, arbitrary, malafide, and lacking in fairness and transparency, and thereby violative of Article 14 of the Constitution of India, and consequently set aside the impugned cancellation of the tender process, and direct the Respondents to forthwith confirm the tender in favour of the Petitioner, who is the successful bidder in the sealed tender process, and to issue the Letter of Award in respect of the subject tender.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings pursuant to the fresh tender notification issued by Respondent No.3, including the auction proposed to be held on 16.04.2026, pending disposal of WP 9847 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the Order of the High Court dated 15.04.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Venkat Sailendra G, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP FOR ENDOWMENTS for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3 and of Sri T.Venu Gopal, Standing Counsel for respondent No.4, the Court made the following

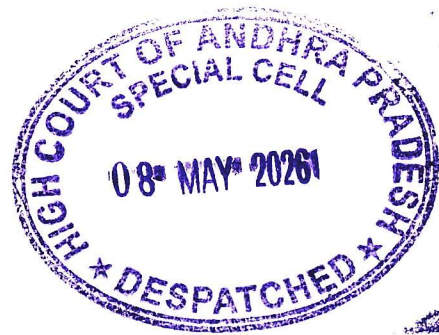
