Heard the learned counsel for the appellant. He submits that the finding on the point of cruelty suffers from perversity and cannot be sustained. 3. The matter requires consideration. 4. Issue notice to the respondent. 5. In addition to the normal mode of service, the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent by Registered Post and Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry before the next date of listing. 6. Post on 29.06.2026. 7. Considering the submissions advanced, as also the consequences vide from the divorce decree, the operation of the decree dated 13.03.2026, passed in H.M.O.P.No.80 of 2022 on the file of the Court of the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amalapuram, shall remain	(contd..)
