Revision Petition Under Section 438 & 442 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to enlarge the petitioner on bail by suspending the sentence imposed in CrI.A.No.28 of 2021 dated 03-02-2026 on the file of VII Additional District & Sessions Judge, Gudur, by confirming the judgment dated 06.02.2021 passed in C.C.No.122 of 2017 passed by the learned First Class Magistrate, Gudur, Pending disposal of CRLRC No. 425 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI KALATHUR CHARISHMA Advocate for the Petitioner and of PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, for the Respondent.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case). The Court made the following

ORDER

"The present interlocutory application was filed under Section 438 (1) of BNSS, 2023 by the petitioners to suspend the conviction and sentence dated 06.04.2021 passed in C.C.No.122 of 2017 on the file of learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gudur, which was confirmed vide Judgement dated 03.02.2026 passed in CrI.A.No.28 of 2021 on the file of learned VII Additional Sessions Judge, Gudur and enlarge the petitioner/accused on bail, pending disposal of the main Criminal revision case.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, since, it is represented that there are merits in the revision preferred by the petitioners, the sentence passed in Judgment dated 06.04.2021 passed in C.C.No. 122 of 2017 on the file of learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gudur, alone is suspended pending disposal of the Criminal Revision Case under the following conditions:

- i. The petitioner/Accused shall be enlarged on bail on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gudur, on the same day.
- ii. That the petitioner shall appear before this Court as and when directed pending disposal of the revision.
