The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s Nimmagadda Revathi, Advocate for the Appellant, the Court made the following.

ORDER

The learned counsel for the appellant is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondents through RPAD and file proof of service before the registry.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that a suit for declaration and permanent injunction was filed, in which the petitioner obtained an order of injunction. The said suit was subsequently decreed, and the appellate court has not granted any suspension of the said judgment.

Considering the same, there shall be an interim direction restraining the respondents from interfering with the possession of the petitioner over the suit schedule property in O.S. No.404 of 2011 on the file of the court of the learned Principal Civil Judge, Eluru.

List the matter after four (04) weeks.
