Dr.YLR,J <u>CrI.P.No.3105 of 2026</u> Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Issue notice to the Respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. Petitioner No.1/Accused No.1 is aged about 44 years, while Respondent No.2 is aged about 42 years. They are wife and husband, and their marriage was solemnized in the year 2014. Respondent No.2 has filed a series of FIRs against the Petitioners. Petitioner No.2 is aged about 76 years and Petitioner No.3 is aged about 70 years; they are the in-laws of Respondent No.2. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and the gravity and nature of the allegations leveled against the Petitioners by Respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr.Kalisetti Apparao, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.	

		Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard. The fee for the mediator will be fixed at a later point of time. Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 04.05.2026 or any other convenient date for both the parties and the mediator. The Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement. Post this matter along with Crl.P.No.7762 of 2022, Crl.P.Nos.1412 and 4242 of 2023, and Crl.P.No.2571 of 2024, as the issues involved are interconnected. It is further directed that mediation shall be conducted in all the aforesaid Criminal Petitions as well, so that the disputes between the parties may be amicably settled. For Mediator's report, post after Summer Vacation, 2026. Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.69 of 2026, on the file of the Vedayapalem Urban Police Station, Nellore District. Dr.YLR,J PRA	
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
