The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief:

“... to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents 3 and 5 in interfering in civil dispute between the petitioner and the respondents 6 to 14 is illegal, arbitrary and contrary to police standing orders and consequently direct the respondents 3 and 5 not to interfere in civil disputes relating to an extent of Ac.0.27 cents in Sy.No.331 of Dudyala Village, Sambepalle Mandal, Annamayya District, Andhra Pradesh and pass ...”

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. Sri D.Kodandarami Reddy, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that Respondent Nos.3 and 5 have been interfering in the civil dispute pending in between the Petitioner and Respondent Nos.6 to 14. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner further submits that a Suit in O.S.No.264/2025 on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Rayachoty was instituted against the unofficial Respondents.

4. Sri P.Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, on written instructions, submits that one Pallapu Nagendra has submitted a complaint to the Respondent No.3 which was registered as a case in Cr.No.164/2025 and after thorough investigation, the police have laid chargesheet and it was numbered as C.C.No.70/2026. Except conducting investigation and filing the chargesheet the police have never interfered in the civil dispute pending in between the Petitioner and the unofficial Respondents.

5. Having regard to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, recording the submissions of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the Respondent Nos.3 and 5 not to

interfere in the civil dispute pending in between he Petitioner and the unofficial Respondents in O.S.No.264/2025 on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Rayachoty without following due process of law.

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
