Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to allow the C.R.P. and set aside the Docket Order dated 24.03.2026 in IA. No. 598 of 2026 in COS. No. 1 of 2026 passed by the Honble Principal District Judge at Ananthapuramu and consequently restrain the Respondent/Defendant and his employees, agents, representatives, and all others acting on his behalf from manufacturing, selling, offering for sale, advertising, directly or indirectly dealing in goods services under the trademark/label RAM - G Gold or any other trademark that is identical or deceptively similar to the Petitioners registered trademark amounting to infringement and passing off, until the final hearing and disposal of IA. No. 598

598 of 2026 in COS. No. 1 of 2026 by the Honble Principal District Judge at Ananthapuramu.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 of CPC is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant an ex-parte ad-interim injunction restraining the Respondent/Defendant and his employees, agents, representatives, and all others acting on his behalf from manufacturing, selling, offering for sale, advertising, directly or indirectly dealing in goods/services under the trademark/label "RAM - G Gold" or any other trademark that is identical or deceptively similar to the Petitioner's registered trademark amounting to infringement and passing off, until the final hearing and disposal of I.A. No. 598 of 2026 in COS. No. 1 of 2026 by the Hon'ble Principal District Judge at Ananthapuramu, Pending disposal of CRP 1101 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier order of the High Court dt.15.04.2026 made in IA.No.1 of 2026 and upon hearing the arguments of SRI DODDALA PRUDHVI TEJA Advocate for the Petitioner, SRI YATTAPU BHARATH KUMAR REDDY Advocate for the Respondent and the Court made the following.

ORDER

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the trial Court has not taken up the hearing of I.A.No.598 of 2026 in C.O.S.No.1 of 2026 which stands posted today before the trial Court, since the Officer is on leave and that the matter has been adjourned to 18.06.2026. Therefore,
