Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or orders particularly the Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of respondents in not regularizing the services of the petitioner as Contingent Sweeper, NTR Telugu Ganga Project Division, Badvel directing to retire from services with effect from 31.01.2026. i.e., 60 years and not continuing up to 62 years despite the issuance of Go.Ms.No.15, dated 31.01.2022, Go.Ms.No.26 dated 19.02.2019, extending all the benefits on par with regular employee including the age of superannuation, sanctioning the Annual Grade Increments as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, contrary to GO.Ms.No.15, dated 31.01.2022 and violative article 14,16 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently c) To direct the respondent to regularize the services of the petitioner as Contingent Sweeper. d) To direct the respondents to continue

the petitioner till attain the age of 62 years i.e., 30.09.2027 on attaining the aged superannuation with all consequential benefits and pass such other orders.

COMMON ORDER:

1. These Writ Petitions are filed questioning the action of Respondents in not continuing the Petitioners in service till they attain the age of 62 years of superannuation on par with the regular employees as provided *vide* G.O.Ms.No.15, Finance (HR.IV-FR&LR) Department, dated 31.01.2022.
2. Learned counsel for the Petitioners would submit that the issue involved in these Writ Petitions is covered by the Common Order dated 21.07.2026 passed by this Court in W.P.No.12413 of 2025 and batch and requested to pass a similar order in these Writ Petitions also.
3. W.P.No.12413 of 2025 and batch is disposed of with the following directions:

(i) The State Government shall examine the issue and take a conscious decision about enhancement of age upto 62 years to non-regular employees working for a substantial number of years in State departments and State owned/controlled entities;

(ii) Till such time, the petitioners/non-regular employees in service shall be continued or till they attain the age of 62 years;

(iii) The petitioners who have retired on attaining the age of 60 years may be considered for re-engagement till 62 years in the event no alternative arrangement is made.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-II does not dispute the same.

5. In view of the same, the Writ Petitions are also disposed of in terms of the Common Order dated 21.07.2026 passed by this Court in W.P.No.12413 of 2025 and batch.

6. There shall be no order as to costs.

7. Registry is directed to attach the copy of Common Order dated 21.07.2026 passed by this Court in W.P.No.12413 of 2025 and batch to this order.

8. As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions if any shall stand dismissed.
