Vallabhaneni Sireesha, learned Standing Counsel takes notice for respondent No.4 and seeks time for filing counter-affidavit. Learned counsel for Writ Petitioners are permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent No.6 through Speed Post/Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and shall file proof of service in the Registry within a period of Three (03) weeks. Learned counsel for the Writ Petitioners would contend that in the Survey No.470-12 at SC Malapeta, Akiveedu village of West Godavari District, there exists an old dilapidated structure, which is being used as Rachha Band, a common meeting place of villagers. But, the unofficial respondents claim that it is an old dilapidated	

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		temple of Lord Sri Rama and attempting to convert the said public place into a permanent religious structure in the name of Ramalayam. Learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.4 submits that without there being any permission from the respective Officials, no untoward action will be taken as alleged by the Writ Petitioners.
