S M SUBHAN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in imposing the punishment of Removal vide Proc No.02/95(164)/2015-Dhone, Dt. 04- 05-2016, which was confirmed by the Appellate authority vide Proc No.St/19(42)/2016-Dy.CTM-Q, Dt. 23.05.2016, and the punishment imposed by the review authority treating the suspension period as not on duty besides imposing the punishment of deferment of 2 annual increments with cumulative effect vide Proc No.PA/675(02)/2021-R M- Nellore, Dt.25-02-2021, is unjust, arbitrary and against to the principles of natural justice, which is contrary all cannons of law and as such liable to be set aside with a consequential direction to the respondents herein to pay the arrears of deference of wages w.e.f.04-05-2016
