Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ order or direction declaring the action of the respondents in issuing impugned proceedings in Rc.No.3046/S1/Tenders/GGH, VJA/2026 dated 11.04.2026 to open sealed tenders on 15.04.2026 (as per Note Order dated 07.04.2026), as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law and violative of Principles of natural Justice, G.O.Ms.No.325 dated 01.11.2011, Clause 11(c), and the judgment of this Hon'ble Court in W.P.No.18513/2025 dated 18.03.2026 and also in utter violation of Article 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set-aside the same.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings pursuant to impugned proceedings in Rc.No.3046/S1/Tenders/GGH, VJA/2026 dated 11.04.2026 to open sealed tenders on 15.04.2026 (as per Note Order dated 07.04.2026), pending disposal of the above W.P.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri PILLI SUNDEEP Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR MEDICAL AND HEALTH for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and the Court made the following:

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Medical and Health and perused the material placed on record.

This Court in its order dated 18.03.2026 specifically directed the Respondent Authorities to proceed with tender process pursuant to the

tender notice already issued by making alterations as necessary to the said tender notice by issuing corrigendum. But in the instant case contrary to the directions of this Court they straight away proceeded with the terms of the tender notice without issuing any corrigendum. Hence the Writ Petition.

For the reasons stated as above, the Respondent No.2 is directed not to finalize the tender on or before 21.04.2026.

Learned Government Pleader for Medical and Health is directed to inform the orders of this Court to the Respondents.
