The respondent No.2 alleges that the petitioner has collected Rs.8 lakhs under the cover of a stamp paper and later has not paid the entire amount; however, he has paid some part payment. An agreement was entered into for the purpose of purchase of land. The nature of the allegations is civil in nature. The respondent No.2 is a retired Deputy Superintendent of Police. Considering the nature and gravity of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the matter	Contd...

is referred to mediation.

Mr.Isukapatla Madhu Babu, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator’s report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.425 of 2025 on the file of Machavaram Police Station, NTR District.
