filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CriminalPetition, the High Court may be pleased to quash FIR/Crime No.30 of 2026, Dt.26.03.2026 on the file of the Macherla Town Station, Macherla, Palnadu District;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.N.V.SURYA DATTU, Advocate for the Petitioner and of PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2, herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CriminalPetition, the High Court may be pleased to stay the entire proceedings in FIR/Crime No.30 of 2026, Dt.26.03.2026 on the file of the Macherla Town Station, Macherla, Palnadu District;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 to 3 are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years.

In the meanwhile, the Investigating Officer is directed to comply with the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar*¹, and also with the provisions of Section 35(3) of the *Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023* (for brevity, 'the BNSS'). However, the petitioners are directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer, and the Investigating Officer may proceed with the further investigation. In the course of investigation, if it is noticed that the petitioners have committed any offence punishable with imprisonment beyond seven years, the Investigating Officer is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Ravi Kiran Kumar Golusu, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 06.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

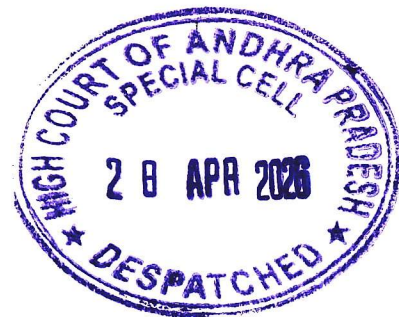
