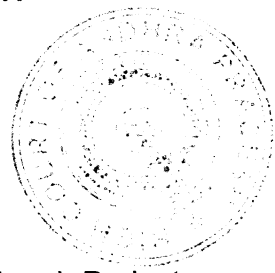

Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of Respondents in not relating the Annual Grade Increments from 2008 onwards and pay Revision to the Petitioner without any reason as illegal, improper, unjust, arbitrary, unconstitutional, contrary to Rule 24 of the Fundamental Rules and violative of principles of natural justice and further direct the respondents to release Annual Grade Increments from 2008 onwards and pay revision to the Petitioner with all consequential benefits including arrears etc.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to release Annual Grade Increments from 2008 onwards and pay revision to the Petitioner pending further orders, pending disposal of WP 13109 of 2020, on the file of the High Court.
