Considering the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the matter is referred to mediation. Ms.Lakshmi Neelima, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.	Contd...

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

List this Criminal Petition along with CrI.P.Nos.1739 and 8198 of 2024. The learned Mediator is directed to conduct mediation in all the connected matters.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.104 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kothuru, Srikakulam District.
