SAPTHAGIRI, presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the proceedings against the

petitioners/Accused No.2 to 4 in CC No. 2712/2025 on the file of the I Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Visakhapatnam;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M. SAPTHAGIRI, Advocate for the Petitioners, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

D.No. 45-38-50, Akkayyapalem, Jagannadhapuram, Visakhapatnam Commissionerate, Andhra Pradesh are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. (under section 482 of Cr.P.C), is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioners /Accused No.2 to 4 in CC No. 2712/2025 on the file of the I Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Visakhapatnam, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3034 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the in-laws of Respondent No. 2. The Respondent No. 2 is the wife of Accused No. 1. It is alleged that the

petitioners never stayed together with Respondent No. 2 and Accused No.1.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Arrabolu Sai Naveen, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.2712 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Visakhapatnam.
