The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Petitioner/Accused No. 1 is the husband of Respondent No.2. Their marriage was solemnized in the year 2022. The petitioner has instituted F.C.O.P. No.3096 of 2026 on the file of the learned Family Court-cum-Principal District Judge, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, on the ground that the marriage was not consummated. Considering the nature and gravity of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the matter is referred to mediation.	Contd...

Sri Gudiseva Hara Gopal, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee of the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No. 2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026 or on any other date convenient to the parties and the Mediator. In case the petitioner is not within India, he is permitted to appear through online mode.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.583 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class-Cum-Principal Junior Civil Judge, Srikakulam.
