AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and grounds/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B V Krishna Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause within Summer Vacation- 2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further Proceedings, including personal appearance of the petitioners A1 in CC.No.583/2025 on file of the Judicial Magistrate of first class cum Principal Junior Civil Judge, Srikakulam in Cr.No.48/2025 of Women PS., Srikakulam, Pending disposal of CRLP No.3036 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Petitioner/Accused No. 1 is the husband of Respondent No.2. Their marriage was solemnized in the year 2022. The petitioner has instituted F.C.O.P. No.3096 of 2026 on the file of the learned Family Court-cum-Principal District Judge, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, on the ground that the marriage was not consummated.

Considering the nature and gravity of the allegations levelled against the petitioner, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Gudiseva Hara Gopal, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee of the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No. 2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026 or on any other date convenient to the parties and the Mediator. In case the petitioner is not within India, he is permitted to appear through online mode.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.583 of 2025 on the file of the

learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class-Cum-Principal Junior Civil Judge, Srikakulam.
