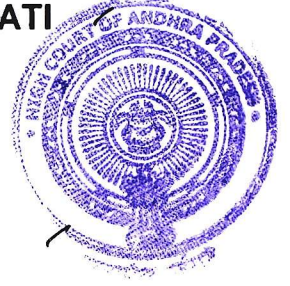

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records relating to PRC No.2 of 2026 on the file of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Nandikotkur, for the alleged offence U/Sec.306 r/w 34 I.P.C. in connection F.I.R.No.95 of 2023 on

the file of the Nandikotkur Police Station, Nandyal District and to quash the proceedings against these petitioners i.e., A1 and A2, and to grant such other relief or reliefs as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in PRC No.2 of 2026 on the file of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Nandikotkur (relating to F.I.R.No. 95 of 2023 on the file of the Nandikotkur Police Station, Nandyal District, for the alleged offence U/Sec.306 r/w 34 I.P.C.), Pending disposal of CRLP No.3037 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri J Janakirami Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioners, and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, and of Sri Varun Byreddy, Advocate for Respondent No.2, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Mr. Varun Byreddy, learned counsel, takes notice for Respondent No. 2.

The Registry is directed to print the name of Mr. Varun Byreddy, learned counsel for Respondent No. 2.

The presence of the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 2 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless their presence is otherwise required.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Hemalata Minchala, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
