Issue notice to respondent No.2. The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Respondent No.2/de-facto complainant is a married woman. She married one Maddala Rahul in the year 2022, and their marriage has not been dissolved in accordance with law. The Respondent No.2 and the petitioner were living together. The Respondent No.2 alleges that the petitioner induced her to marry him and had sexual intercourse with her on several occasions, and also took money from her. The Respondent No. 2 has lodged a written complaint running into two pages, wherein she has levelled several allegations against the petitioner. 		<i>West Bengal², Bhawar Singh v. State of Madhya Pradesh³, Mahesh Damu Khare v. State of Maharashtra⁴ and Rajnish Singh v. State of U.P⁵</i>, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr.Jala Sanjaya Virgil, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case. The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard. The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator. The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement. Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator’s report.
