WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri YASWANTH GADE, presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records in FIR.No. 88/2026 on the file of the Station House Officer, Bhimavaram II Town Police Station, Bhimavaram, West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh and quash the same as the same is illegal, abuse of process of law;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri YASWANTH GADE, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including arrest of the petitioner/Accused in FIR.No. 88/2026 on the file of the Station House Officer, Bhimavaram II Town Police Station, Bhimavaram, West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh pending disposal of CRLP No. 3045 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard Sri K.Chidambaram, the learned Senior Counsel, representing Mr. G.Yaswanth, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Respondent No.2/de-facto complainant is a married woman. She married one Maddala Rahul in the year 2022, and their marriage has not been dissolved in accordance with law. The Respondent No.2 and the petitioner were living together. The Respondent No.2 alleges that the petitioner induced her to marry him and had sexual intercourse with her on several occasions, and also took money from her. The Respondent

No. 2 has lodged a written complaint running into two pages, wherein she has levelled several allegations against the petitioner.

Considering and the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and also the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Amol Bhagwan Nehul v. State of Maharashtra¹**, **Kunal Chatterjee v. State of West Bengal²**, **Bhawar Singh v. State of Madhya Pradesh³**, **Mahesh Damu Khare v. State of Maharashtra⁴** and **Rajnish Singh v. State of U.P⁵**, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Jala Sanjaya Virgil, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 04.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, the Investigating Officer is directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner.
