Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ Order or direction particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus is filed to seek the quashing of the rowdy Sheet bearing C. No 01 / Row/ CZ- RJMY/2025 dated 06.01.2025, has been opened and is being continued against the petitioner in Form No. 66 under the Andhra Pradesh Police Manual (A.P.P.M.) as per Order No. 601 of A.P.P.M., Part-I, Volume-II, in the concerned police stations of the respondents which is highly illegal, arbitrary and violative of the petitioner's fundamental rights guaranteed under Article 14,16,21,300A and principles of natural justice and violative of Orders in WA No 674 of 2022 dated 12.09.2022 and unconstitutional as the respondents action in maintaining the Rowdy Sheet which contravene Andhra Pradesh Police Standing Orders and the principles laid down by this Hon'ble Court and consequently set aside the impugned Rowdy Sheet No. C. No. 01/Row/CZ-RJMY/2025 dated 06.01.2025 as it is violative of his fundamental rights under Articles 14 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India;

IA NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent police

authorities to refrain from summoning and calling the petitioner to the police station without adhering to due process of law, pending disposal of WP.No.11190 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Regulagadda Venkatesh, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Home for Respondent Nos.1 to 9, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

At request of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, post the matter after four weeks, for filing counter.

In the meanwhile, the respondent authorities shall follow the procedure directed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in its order dated 12.09.2022 in I.A.No.01 of 2022 in Writ Appeal No.674 of 2022, for summoning the Petitioner to the police station on account of the pending suspect sheet.
