India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or writs more particularly in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the impugned action of the 4th respondent in ordering recovery of alleged misappropriated amount of Rs.57,810/-, vide impugned Proc.No.K5/019/2026 Dated.4-2-2026 without any notice or opportunity and set aside the same by holding it as illegal, arbitrary, high handed, violation of principles of natural justice and cannot be justified in the eye of law and consequently direct the respondents not to recover any amount from the petitioner in the interest of justice;
