The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice for the respondent Nos.1 to 5, to file counter affidavit. This writ petition is filed questioning the endorsement issued by the 3rd respondent dated 09.03.2026 declaring that the petitioners are not entitled for claiming mutation over the subject property since the 6th respondent's father is alive and he is only entitled for the same and accordingly, mutated in the name of the 6th respondent herein. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners approached the 3rd respondent against the endorsement of the 4th respondent dated 08.01.2026, without giving any opportunity to the petitioners, the above said impugned endorsement has been passed by the 3rd respondent dated 09.03.2026. In view of the above said facts and circumstances, there shall be an order of *status quo* as on today to be maintained with respect to the mutation of names of the parties concerned for the subject land covered under the impugned endorsement of the 3rd respondent dated 09.03.2026, till the next date of hearing.
