Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a appropriate Writ Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, declaring the action of the Respondent No.3 in interfering with the possession of the Petitioner land to an extent of 0.90 cents of Madamanuru, Manubolu Mandal, SPSR Nellore District and trying to dispossess the Petitioner from lawful possession and enjoyment as illegal, arbitrary violation of Article 14, 21 and 300-A of the constitution of India Consequently direct the Respondents not to interfere and dispossess the Petitioner and pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to interfere with the Petitioner possession and enjoyment of property to an extent of 0.90 cents in Sy.No. 731-2 of Madamanuru , Manubolu Mandal, SPSR Nellore District pass

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

2. This Writ Petition is filed questioning the action of the 3rd respondent in interfering with the possession of the petitioner's land in an extent of Ac.0.90 cents situated in Sy.No.731-2 of Madamanuru Village, Manubolu Mandal, SPSR Nellore District and trying to dispossess the petitioner from his lawful possession and enjoyment.

3. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, relying upon the written instructions of the 3rd respondent dated 17.04.2026, submits that the petitioner has encroached the land in an extent of Ac.0.90 cents in Sy.No.731, which is classified as Canal Poramboke as per the RSR of the village. The field staff, during the course of normal inspections, noticed that the petitioner has encroached the Canal Poramboke and raised acid lemon. The field staff orally instructed to vacate the Government land, as it is highly objectionable. The encroachments made in the Canal Proambokes are highly objectionable and liable for eviction.

4. In view of the above said facts and circumstances and upon recording the written instructions of the 3rd respondent dated 17.04.2026, the respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to deal with the subject land in an extent of Ac.0.90 cents situated in Sy.No.731-2 of Madamanuru Village, Manubolu Mandal, SPSR Nellore District, strictly in accordance with law and if the petitioner is otherwise found to be in possession of the same, he shall be dealt

with strictly in accordance with law, by hearing all the parties concerned, including the petitioner, giving due opportunity, upon verification of the records and the subject land, appropriate decision shall be taken on its own merits. Any dispossession from the subject land shall not be made, except by following the due process of law.

5. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, Interlocutory Applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
