WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/s Sodum Anvesha, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ, order or appropriate Direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the proceedings of Respondent No.4 vide R.C.No.1566/Trg-1/2024-25 dated 06-08-2025 and the consequential Memo Rc.No.1533/Trg.1/2025 dated 01.11.2025 in directing the petitioner to undergo 42 week induction training afresh as illegal, arbitrary, unfair, discriminatory, unreasonable, unconstitutional and unsustainable and consequently direct the respondents to permit the petitioner to resume and complete the remaining period of induction training in Respondent No.4 college.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mrs Sodum Anvesha, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP for Services – I for the Respondents, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
