Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that infact the petitioner has filed a letter dated 25.08.1988 with translation before the Court below. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that it is only a letter dated 25.08.1988. So, there is no necessity for making any stamp duty on the said document. Even if at all, the court feels that there is any stamp duty to be paid, the Court can refer the matter to appropriate authority for collateral purpose, but the Court below straightaway rejected the impugned application. 3.
