Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the Order dated 05.3.2026 passed by Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) at Eluru in IA No. 296/2024 in OS No. 19 of 2018 by allowing the revision.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to order stay of all further proceedings in OS No. 19/2018 on the file of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) at Eluru, Pending disposal of CRP 1163 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI YALLABANDI RAMATIRTHA Advocate for the Petitioner, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

Aggrieved by the order dated 05.03.2026, passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) at Eluru in IA No.296 of 2024 in O.S.No. 19 of 2018, the present civil revision petition is filed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that infact the petitioner has filed a letter dated 25.08.1988 with translation before the Court below. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that it is only a letter dated 25.08.1988. So, there is no necessity for making any stamp duty on the said document. Even if at all, the court feels that there is any stamp duty to be paid, the Court can refer the matter to appropriate authority for collateral purpose, but the Court below straightaway rejected the impugned application.

3. Considering the said submissions and on perusal of the record, there shall be stay of all further proceedings for a period of eight weeks.
