**“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.**

**Issue notice to respondent No.3.**

**The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.3 and file proof to that effect.**

**The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioners/Accused are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years and are compoundable in nature; therefore, the matter is referred to mediation.**

**Ms.Jyothi Lakshmi Midthipati, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.**

**The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.**

**The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.**

**The petitioners and Respondent No.3 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.**

**The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.**

**Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator’s report.**

**Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.76 of 2024 on the file of the learned Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Thamballapalle.”**

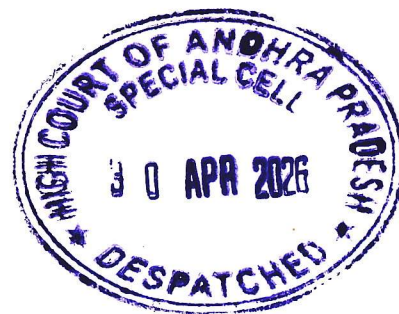
