WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri V Vinod K Reddy, presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the FIR No. 204 of 2025 dated 09.11.2025 on the file of the Athreyapuram Police Station, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema District, against the petitioners herein, in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V Vinod K Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioners, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings against the petitioners in FIR.No.204 of 2025 dated 09.11.2025, on the file of the Athreyapuram Police Station, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema District, Pending disposal of CRLP No.3170 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

It appears that the de facto complainant has arraigned all the inhabitants of the street as accused, alleging that they trespassed into the disputed property.

Considering the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, and the offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Kalisetti Apparao, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.204 of 2025 on the file of Athreyapuram Police Station.
