Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.1125 of 2025 on the file of the Hon'ble II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, against the petitioners No.2 & 3 /accused No.2 & 3 herein

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Rayalcheruvu Abishek Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1125 of 2025 on the file of the Hon'ble II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, Pending disposal of CRLP No. 3244 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the in-laws of the respondent No.2. The marriage of accused No.1 and respondent No.2 was performed on 12.08.2022.

Considering the entire allegations leveled against the petitioner and the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. K.T.Sudha Sree, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 05.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation proceedings for amicable settlement of the dispute.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1125 of 2025 on the file of the learned II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
