The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief:

“...to issue a Writ, order or direction, especially one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, inaction of 4th Respondent not to comply the order passed by the Hon’ble Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class, Gudur in CrI.MP.No.390/2025 in C.C.No.371/2024 date 03-10-2025 is illegal, arbitrary and violating the Article 14 of Constitution of India And consequently direct the respondents to conduct further investigate in Crime No.28/2024 strictly the terms of the Hon’ble Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gudur...”

2. Heard the learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. Mr. Lingala Hazarathaiah, learned counsel for the Petitioner, submits that Respondent No.4 has failed to comply with the order passed by the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Gudur, in CrI.M.P.No.390 of 2025 in C.C.No.371 of 2024, dated 03.10.2025.

4. Sri P. Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader, submits that Respondent No.4 is in the process of complying with the order and the necessary steps are going on, and the required material will be supplied shortly.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and the submissions of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the Respondent No.4 to scrupulously follow the directions of the learned Magistrate passed in CrI.M.P.No.390 of 2025 in

C.C.No.371 of 2024, dated 03.10.2025, and to file an appropriate report before the jurisdictional Magistrate within four (04) weeks from the date of receipt of this order, by supplying a copy to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
