Petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure code/ Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in SC/ST Case No.3 of 2026 on the file of the Court of IV Additional District & Sessions Judge -cum -Trial Court of SC/ST Cases at Vizianagaram, Vizayanagaram District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3163 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and the learned counsel for the respondent No.2.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2 are majors and fully grown persons. They have been in a relationship for quite a long time.

Considering and the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and also the law laid down by the Hon’ble Apex Court in Amol Bhagwan Nehul v. State of Maharashtra¹, Kunal Chatterjee v. State of West Bengal², Bhawar Singh v. State of Madhya Pradesh³, Mahesh Damu Khare v. State of Maharashtra⁴ and Rajnish Singh v. State of U.P⁵, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms. Kalva Rama Tulasi, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator’s report.
