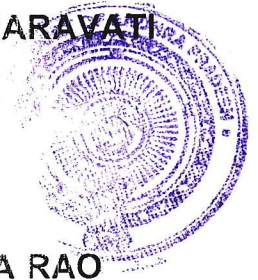

WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI P SAI SURYA TEJA presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the Charge-Sheet in C.C.No. 2325 of 2025 on the file of the VI Additional Judicial Magistrate Court, Vijayawada.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P

SAI SURYA TEJA Advocate for the Petitioners, Assistant Public Prosecutor for the respondent no.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.2, herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an advocate on or before 15.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS/ u/s 482 of CrPC is filed, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in C.C.No. 2325 of 2025 before the VI Additional Judicial Magistrate Court, Vijayawada, including appearance of the petitioners, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3110 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Respondent No.2 lodged a complaint, which was registered as Crime No.787 of 2020 on the file of Penamaluru Police Station for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 506 and 509 read with Section 34 of 'the I.P.C.' Within one month thereafter, a suit in O.S.No.1229 of 2020 was instituted on the file of the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Vijayawada. The said suit is between the accused in the crime and the Secretary of Laxmi Towers Apartment Welfare Association. The allegations made in the complaint and those raised in the suit are more or less the same.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and the gravity and nature of the allegations leveled against the Petitioners by Respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation.

Kandikattu Narasimha Rao, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The fee for the mediator will be fixed at a later point of time.

Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 04.05.2026 or any other convenient date for both the parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

For Mediator's report, post after Summer Vacation, 2026.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.2325 of 2025, on the file of the learned VI Additional Judicial Magistrate, Vijayawada.
