Let counter-affidavit be filed within four weeks and reply-affidavit, if any, may be filed within two weeks thereafter. 3. List the matter after eight weeks along with W.P. No.27043 of 2024 and batch. <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> 1. Petitioners herein were engaged as NMRs as Non-Technical workers i.e Work Inspectors like Typist, in the respondent organization on 06.12.1991. Subsequently vide G.O.Ms.No.266 dated 13.10.2009, the Government has extended the benefit of minimum time scale of pay to the petitioners also attached to the post along with others. The petitioner herein was also extended the benefit of increments and release of annual grade increments, HRA and fixation of pay in revised pay scales vide order dated 31.07.2018, passed by this W.P.No.26467 of 2018. While things stood thus, the petitioner will be completing the age of 60 years of service as on 30.06.2026 and liable to be retired on 30.06.2026 as the Government orders which were issued	Contd...

		vide G.O.Ms.No.15, Finance Department dated 31.01.2022 wherein made an amendment to the AP Public Employment (Regulation Age of Superannuation) Act, 1984 and enhanced the age of superannuation from 60 years to 62 years w.e.f.01.01.2022. Accordingly, the petitioner is also entitled to continue till 62 years and liable for retirement on 30.06.2028. 2. This Court on 25.03.2025, in W.P.No.27043 of 2024 and batch, considered the relatively similar issue and granted benefit of extension of age of superannuation from 60 years to 62 years to the petitioner therein. 3. Following the same, there shall be interim direction to respondents herein to continue the petitioner till they attain the age of superannuation of 62 years, until further orders. DR, J Gk	
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
