The Petitioner No.1/Accused No.2 is aged about 75 years and she is bedridden. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, nature and gravity of the allegations leveled against the Petitioners by Respondent No.2, the matter is referred to mediation. Mr.Habeeb Sheikh, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case. Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.	

		The fee for the mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time. The Petitioner Nos.2 & 3/Accused Nos.3 & 4 and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 04.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator and co-operate with the mediation proceedings for an amicable settlement of the dispute. The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.
