The Petitioner Nos.2 & 3/Accused Nos.3 & 4 and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 04.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator and co-operate with the mediation proceedings for an amicable settlement of the dispute. ✓

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement. ✓
