WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI ANUMULA VAMSI KRISHNA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the

Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the inaction of the respondents in not initiating any action against the unauthorized aqua culture activities carried out by 6th respondent without there being having any permissions contrary to the specific guidelines issued under G.O.Ms. No.7 Animal Husbandry Dairy Development and Fisheries Fish II Department and also in violation of the provisions of the Andhra Pradesh State Aquaculture Development Authority Act 2020 and consequently direct the official respondents to take action against the unauthorized aqua culture conducted by 6th respondent.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri ANUMULA VAMSI KRISHNA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Fisheries for Respondent No.1 to 5 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 4th respondent to take action against illegal cultivation of fishing tanks, pending disposal of WP No. 11087 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Issue Notice to the Respondent(s) returnable in four weeks.

Pursuant to the Orders of this Court in W.P. No. W.P.No.33615 of 2023, dated 24.01.2024 and W..No.38 of 2024, dt. 12.01.2024, a skill test was conducted on 06.03.2024 for admission into the Respondent No.6 Fishermen Cooperative Society. In the skill test, as the Petitioner was qualified, Proceedings, dated 13.08.2024 were issued directing the Respondent No.6 to admit the Petitioner and other qualified members as members of the Society. However, the Respondent No.6 Society, without admitting the Petitioner and other persons who are qualified in the skill test conducted, is continuing fishing operations in the tanks leased out to them through the unauthorized persons, who are not the members of the Society. Though this issue is being urged by the Petitioner and other persons, the Respondents are not considering their request. Hence, the present Writ Petition.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader submits that the grievance of the Petitioner would be examined at the earliest.

Considering the submissions made, the Respondent Authorities are directed to examine the grievance of the Petitioner with regard to fishing

activity by non members of the Respondent No.6 Society as expeditiously as possible.
