Petition under Section 528 of BNSS./482 of Cr.P.C., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CriminalPetition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in D.VC. No. 05 Of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate Of First Class: Dhone, including dispense with personal appearance of the Accused No. 2 to 4 / petitioners herein;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Petitioner No.1/Accused No.2 is the mother-in-law, Petitioner No.2/Accused No.3 is the sister-in-law of Respondent No.2, and Petitioner No.3/Accused No.4 is the husband of Petitioner No.2.

Considering the nature of the allegations leveled against the Petitioners by Respondent No.2, and as the offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Gudiseva Hara Gopal, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 and co-operate with the mediation proceedings for an amicable settlement of the dispute.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Since Petitioner No.1/Accused No.2 is suffering from Alzheimer's disease, she is exempted from appearing before the mediator for settlement proceedings.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.05 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Dhone.
