Petition under Section 528 of BNSS., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CriminalPetition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including presence of the Petitioners in relating to S.C.No. 1128/2025 on the file of court of the V Addl. District & Sessions Judge, Guntur, pending disposal of the main criminal petition;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Petitioner No.1 is the son of Petitioner No.2. Petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2 were in a relationship for a considerable period of time. Later, due to misunderstandings and the interference of elders on both sides, the matter reached the Police Station by way of lodgment of a complaint by Respondent No.2.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Nalluri Yashodha Kumari, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.C.No.1128 of 2025 on the file of the learned V Additional District and Sessions Judge, Guntur.
