WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. M K RAJ KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order, writ or direction more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus under Article 226 of the Constitution of India questioning the action of the respondents in involving the civil dispute between the petitioner and the 4th respondent herein vide OS.No.1603 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Junior Civil Judge, Guntur and threatening the petitioner to vacate the subject property by colluding with the 4th respondent by the 5th and 6th respondents herein even though the petitioner made a complaint against the 4th respondent that forcibly entering into the subject property which is subject matter of OS.No.1603 of 2025 is illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents No.3, 5 and 6 herein not to interfere with the civil dispute which is pending before the I Additional Junior Civil Judge, Guntur

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M K RAJ KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Home for respondent Nos. 1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 4 to 6, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the Respondent Nos.4 to 6 and file proof to that effect.

In view of the pendency of the civil suit in O.S. No. 1603 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Junior Civil Judge, Guntur, between the Petitioner and the unofficial Respondents, the respondent police are directed not to call the Petitioner to the police station unnecessarily for the purpose of settlement of the civil dispute.
