WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI.M.RAVINDRA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ or Direction or Order, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the proceedings of the 2nd Respondent in R.O.C. No.1950/2015/A1, dt.28-03-2024 directing the petitioner to vacate the Municipal Shop No.2 (Front Row), N.T.R. Municipal Shopping complex, Old Bus Stand, Gudur, Tirupathi District by paying the revised rental balance upto 31.05.2024 as illegal, arbitrary. Unjust and in violation of A.P.Municipalities Act, 1965, Articles 14, 19(1)(g) and 21 of

Constitution of India and to set aside the same and consequently direct the Respondents to extend the lease period in terms of G.O.Rt.No.665, Dt.11.10.2023.
