Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioners/Accused No. 1 and 3. in C.C No. 6160 of 2022 on the file of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate: Vijayawada City, for the offences U/Sec. 498 - (A) I PC and Section 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act., against the petitioners/Accused Nos. 1 and 3, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3167 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 3 are the brothers. The petitioner/Accused No.1 is the husband of Respondent No.2.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Habeeb Sheikh, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.6160 of 2022 on the file of the learned II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada City,
