The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The petitioners are the in-laws of Respondent No.2.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.K.T.Sudha Sree, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioners and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 05.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation–2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.32 of 2026 on the file of Kuppam Urban Police Station, Chittoor District.
